

# 2005-2006 SWADESH DEROY SCHOLARSHIP

## INFORMATION SHEET

**WHAT:** The FCCJ plans to present three scholarship awards for the 2006-2007 academic year to deserving students. The first place prize will be 500,000 yen, second place prize 300,000 yen and third place 200,000 yen. The prizes are lump sum unconditional gift awards, not loans.

**WHO:** The scholarship is open to any undergraduate or graduate student in Japan with an expected graduation date after 2006. The competition is open to both Japanese citizens and foreigners.

**HOW:** Students can apply by submitting an application form, a resume, a passport size photo and **ONE** of the following: 800-2,000 word article (published or unpublished); 1.5 minute - 4 minute television story package; or a selection of five 8x10 or 11x14 photos (color or black and white).
