I. General Information

1. In general, we publish brief theses, articles, research notes, fieldwork reports related to Cambodia and Southeast Asia. The deadline for submission is at the end September.

2. The editorial board, which is organized by the director, will decide to accept, or reject the contributed article. The editorial committee reserves the right to insist on correction being made in the articles.

3. All copyrights will belong to the Sophia Asia Center, Sophia University

II. Details Concerning Submission

1. Formatting

- (1) Articles should be typed out using computer software on A4 size paper. All articles should be submitted electronically (both in Word and PDF format).
- (2) Articles should be in Time New Roman 12 point, 1.5 spaced. Block quotes and endnotes are single spaced (11 point).
- (3) Accents in foreign words should be maintained on capital letter: École
- (4) Photographs, figures, and tables have to be submitted electronically. Please indicate their sizes and location in the main text.
- 2. For usage of language other than Japanese or English (Khmer and French language), please consult the editor.
- 3. Endnotes
 - (1) Only endnotes are permitted, and they are to be inserted using Arabic numerals.
 - (2) Note numbers appearing in the text are to be placed with brackets using Arabic numerals, as for \dots^2
 - (3) Numbers indicating diagrams, illustrations, maps, and so on should be inserted in brackets using Arabic numerals as for example (Map 1).
- 4. In the text, the references should be cited as [Ishizawa 2012: 25-40].
