Note 1: Lectures, arrangement and cleaning of artifacts have been done at the Sophia Asia Center for Research and Human Development from 1996 (The name was renamed from "Angkor Study Office" in October 2002).

Note 2: Intensive Courses at the Royal University of Fine Arts were held for approximately 11 times (total number of times) on 16 subjects in seven years from March 1991 to May 1997.
