## Professor Murata of Sophia University and Mr. Kawamura, Noh master, gave lectures in Ukraine

Professor Shin'ichi Murata, the Institute Fellow of European Institute Sophia University Tokyo, gave lectures on Japanese Noh culture in Ukraine with Mr. Haruhisa Kawamura, a Noh master of Kyoto's Kawamura Noh Theatre.
