His research concentrates on international security, post-conflict peacebuilding, political violence and security governance. He has published *Arms and the State*, edited or co-edited *Critical Security Studies*, *Culture and Security*, and *Armed Groups and Contemporary Conflicts*, as well as having authored dozens of articles and book chapters.
