

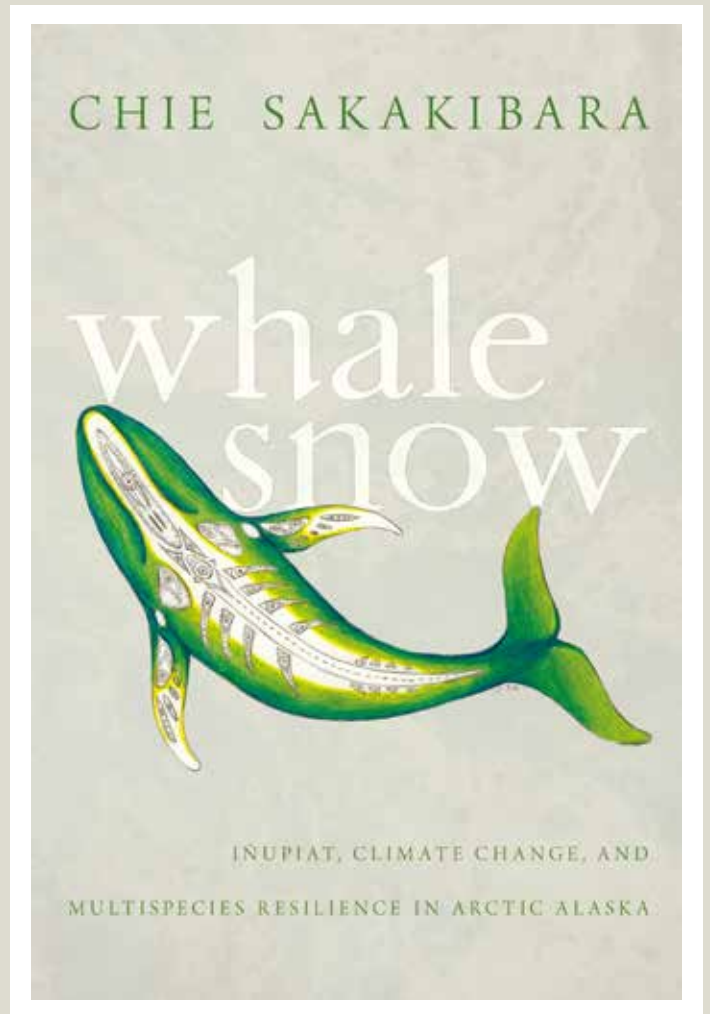

## Biography

Chie Sakakibara is an assistant professor of environmental studies at Oberlin College. She was trained in cultural geography, art history, and Native American & Indigenous studies. Her work explores human dimensions of global climatic and environmental change among Indigenous peoples. Native to Japan, Sakakibara is a proud adoptive member of three Iñupiaq whaling crews in northern Alaska. Her love of humans and nonhuman animals manifests in her academic work as well as in her life with one human daughter, Injutuq (meaning Baby Whale in the Iñupiaq language; pictured here), and two canine sons, Girō and Ferrin.
